AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WEIGHT LIMITS ON BARNARD MILL ROAD (FROM RT. 31 TO VAN BUREN ST.)

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2-1 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING WEIGHT LIMITS ON BARNARD MILL ROAD (FROM RT. 31 TO VAN BUREN ST.)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Motor Vehicle and Traffic Ordinance of the Village of Ringwood is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision as and for Section 12-1008.2 thereof:

Section 12-1008.1 WHEEL AND AXLE LOADS AND GROSS WEIGHTS ON BARNARD MILL ROAD (FROM RT. 31 TO VAN BUREN ST.) No vehicle or combination of vehicles shall be operated, unladen or with load, upon Barnard Mill Road, from Route 31 to Van Buren Street, in the Village of Ringwood when the gross weight on the road surface through any axle thereof exceeds 8,000 pounds. An axle load shall be defined as the total load transmitted to the road by all wheels whose centers may be included between two parallel transverse vertical planes 40" apart extending across the full width of the vehicles. Any two or more consecutive axles whose centers are more than 40" and no more than 72" apart, measured to the nearest inch between any two adjacent axles in series, shall be defined as tandem axles and the gross weight transmitted to the road surface through such series shall not exceed 16,000 pounds and no axle of the series shall exceed the maximum weight permitted under this section for a single axle. A truck specially equipped with a self-compactor and used exclusively for garbage or refuse operations, may, however, when laden with garbage or refuse, transmit upon the road surface of any highway a gross weight upon a single axle

of no more than 22,000 pounds and upon a tandem axle no more than 40,000 pounds. When unladen, however, such truck shall comply with the axle limitations applicable to all other trucks.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less that Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
