ORDINANCE NO. 6-4-03 GARBAGE AND TRASH CONTAINER ENCLOSURES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1. In the case of R-3 Multiple Family Residential Districts, Business Districts, Office/Research Districts and Industrial District Premises, all garbage and trash containers shall be kept in a stockade wood fence or masonary/concrete enclosure located in the rear yard setback of the premises from which it is to be collected except on the days scheduled for collection. The fenced enclosure shall be not less than 6 feet in height from the ground level and all fence posts and supporting fence members shall be erected so that after the fence is constructed the fence post and supporting members will face to the interior of the fence enclosure.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense committed on each day during, or on which, a violation occurs or continues.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the terms and provisions hereof, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by and under the authority of the Corporate Authorities of the Village.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
