## ORDINANCE NO. 96- /0-7

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ZONING DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION OF NEWLY ANNEXED TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

IN THE MATTER OF MCHENRY STATE
BANK, as Trustee under Trust
No. 2385 FOR ANNEXATION OF LAND
TO THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD,
MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the following described real estate has been newly annexed to the Village of Ringwood, McHenry County, Illinois, towit:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 45 North, Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the East line of said Southwest Quarter with the Northerly right of way line of State Route 31; thence Northwesterly along the Northerly right of way line of State Route 31, a distance of 298.87 feet; thence Northwesterly along said Northerly right of way line being along a curve to the right having a radius of 2082.2 feet and being tangent to the last described course a distance of 1.13 feet; thence Northerly parallel with the East line of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 10 a distance of 579.34 feet; thence Easterly at right angles of the last described course a distance of 274.45 feet to a point on the East line of said Southwest Quarter that is 700.50 feet Northerly of the place of beginning; thence Southerly along said East line being at right angles to the last described course a distance of 700.50 feet to the place of beginning, in McHenry County, Illinois.

WHEREAS, the above described real estate is subject to an Annexation Agreement which provides, among other things, that upon annexation thereof to the Village of Ringwood, Illinois, the aforesaid territory shall be zoned in accordance with the terms and provisions contained in said Annexation Agreement; and

WHEREAS, prior to the annexation of the above described territory and the entry into the aforesaid Annexation Agreement between the parties therein, all public hearings required by law to be held were conducted and held pursuant to the proper legal notice theretofore given.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RINGWOOD, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the above described real estate and territory is hereby zoned in accordance with the terms and provisions of Exhibit "B" of the above Annexation Agreement adopted this same date.

SECTION 2: The Official Zoning Map of the Village of Ringwood, IL shall reflect the permitted uses of the aforesaid premises as set forth in Exhibit "B" of the Annexation Agreement.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


